** In N332 Caring for Clients at Camp, students are divided into 2 groups. The first group starts the evening of Friday, July 22, (6:00 pm) and leaves Monday evening (10:00 pm), July 25. The second group arrives at 11:00 am Monday, July 25 and leaves at noon on Thursday, July 28. This overlap is planned to facilitate a smooth transition. Students are required to be in residence at the camp 24 hours per day and adhere to camp policies such as "no smoking" on campgrounds.

Note: Insufficient enrollment (less than 10, or less than the cap) may necessitate cancellation of a course offering.
